From The Five Parts of Art

Artists Use Lines

Lines are outlines or edges of shapes and objects. They let us see the shapes an artist creates.

Artists used different kinds of lines to paint these colorful bowls.



Lines can be straight or wavy. They can have curved or sharp corners. They can be thick or thin. Artists use different kinds of lines to send different messages.



An artist used wavy lines to paint the waves in the ocean. The wavy lines show how the water is always moving.

An artist used straight lines to draw these trees. Straight lines show how the trees stand up tall.
