



Listen to a Book Hub?

Students build phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension skills by listening to real humans read the words in the story as they are highlighted. Teachers can use books during small group reading to teach skills. Students can practice applying those skills independently at their desks and at home. These books can also be used at home for reading practice.

Each book highlights one single phonogram and gives examples of words that include the same sound along with engaging pictures that reinforce letter-sound connections. Words vary in length from three letters to multisyllables. The phonogram is in a contrasting color to clearly show visually where it is in each word. Full-color photographs bring the words to life.

PHONICS STORIES

Practice application of specific phonograms with a variety of funny illustrated stories and nonfiction informational text. Beginning readers practice in books with limited sight words. More advanced readers apply their phonics knowledge to more complex stories.

WORDS

Build vocabulary in books where single words are paired with vibrant images to reinforce the reader's knowledge of familiar words and aid in learning new topic-related vocabulary including colors, apple orchard, shapes, seasons, and people in my neighborhood. Beginning writers can use these books to support their writing skills.

NURSERY RHYMES AND SONGS

Build language skills with classic Mother Goose nursery rhymes and songs including Humpty Dumpty, Mary Had a Little Lamb, The Wheels on the Bus, and Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star.

COLORS

Build color recognition skills, vocabulary, and reading skills with books about a variety of colors.

MATH

Listen to books about counting, addition, subtraction, measuring, and sorting.

MY FIRST CHAPTER BOOK

Developing readers build reading fluency, decoding skills, and comprehension with three levels of chapter books. Silly stories with fun characters and colorful illustrations encourage readers to challenge themselves with more difficult text.

Learn about manners, feelings, disabilities, and social-emotional skills with colorful illustrated stories and nonfiction books.

WHERE I LIVE






What is

What is Read a Book with a Partner Hub?

Parent and caregiver involvement has been linked to student achievement. The Read a Book with a Partner Hub has books that are designed for shared reading between a young reader and an adult or proficient reader. Each of the six levels includes a support page for caregivers and teachers. Level 1 books include vocabulary words and sight words. Level 2 books include a glossary and comprehension questions with answers. Levels 3 through level 6 books include a glossary and comprehension questions with answers.

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
